Motion was made by Upchurch and seconded by Crenshaw to approve the Minutes of the previous meetings of August 2010 and September 2010. Motion carried. Motion was made by Wolf and seconded by Upchurch to approve the Collector's and Treasurer's Reports of August 2010. Motion carried. Motion was made by Crenshaw and seconded by Phillips to accept the List of Appropriations for August and July. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION - Reduce Number of Accounting Funds

Upchurch motioned to accept the Resolution to reduce the number of accounting funds within the City of Canton Budget and Phillips seconded the motion. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION - Amend the 2010-2011 City of Canton Budget

Upchurch motioned and Phillips seconded to approve the proposed resolution to amend the 2010-2011 City of Canton Budget. Wolf stated there was a discrepancy with the resolution. Upchurch withdrew her motion.

TOURISM COMMISSION

Jen Hiller, Chairman of the Tourism Commission presented the latest projects undertaken by the Tourism Commission. Including the new City sign south of town, the posting of a new billboard along highway 61 just south of the Eighteen Wheeler, and the latest undertaking created by Jim Upchurch to develop ecotourism along the Mississippi riverfront and the City wetlands.

COTTON BOWL LEASE

Wolf motioned to approve the annual lease with Culver Stockton College for the Cotton Bowl baseball and softball field located at 603 North 10th Street. Phillips seconded the motion and the motion carried.

CONSENT AGENDA

Kell proposed the Board of Alderman adopt the use of a consent agenda. The consent agenda would be used for items that the board would normally approve without comment. The items on the consent agenda are marked with asterisks and an item can be removed from the consent agenda by request. One motion and a second would approve all items on the consent agenda. POLICE DEPARTMENT PROMOTIONS

Mayor Fretwell reported to the Board of Aldermen that Corporal Shelley was promoted to Sergeant with a wage increase to \$14.00 an hour. Officer Bell was promoted to corporal with a wage increase to \$12.00 an hour. Crenshaw requested if the wage increases were within the Police Department budget? Chief Hudnall reported the wage increases were within the police department budget.

OTHER BUSINESS

Fretwell reported Culver-Stockton College's Homecoming is October 1st and 2nd and encourage those present to enjoy the parade and the football game.

Wolf spoke in regards to the draft ordinance on wood burning outdoor furnaces in the weekly packet. It was agreed the wood burning furnace committee would meet again to further discuss and address additional concerns. Smith will contact DNR in regards to additional information to assist the committee with, indoor wood burning furnaces, flue height and emissions.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chief Hudnall commented that maybe the Tourism Commission might consider activities geared toward the college students.

Jennifer Smith mentioned Culver-Stockton College has an arts management program and an internship could be utilized with the City of Canton.

Alderman Janney arrived at this time 7:41 pm.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

Crenshaw reported the committee discussed the sidewalk replacement program and it is at the public works director discretion if sidewalk replaced needs to be picture framed or not picture framed. The City of Canton has worked out an agreement with Canton Special Road District to mow the Eleventh Street ditch in exchange for rent on the City's Morton Building.

John Deere Tractor and Bucket

Crenshaw motioned and Dodd seconded for the City to proceed with the purchase of a John Deere 310SJ for the purchase price of \$90,700 less \$18,000 trade in allowance on the City's current 1994 Case 580SK for a total balance of \$72,700 to be financed over the next three years at 3.5%. Hausdorf explained the new piece of equipment comes with a five-year full coverage maintenance contract and the bucket comes with a warranty for the life of the machine. Motion carried.

CENTRAL PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

Fretwell explained the installation of the new equipment at Central Park requires the installation of 28 posts. Fretwell authorized the purchase of a posthole digger to assist with this project. The rental of a posthole digger would have been comparable to the purchase price. Hausdorf explained with the deadline for completion of the trail project the playground installation will be postponed until spring.

POLICE COMMITTEE


Janney reported the Committee met and approved new reserve officers, providing an on-line internship, and the purchase of Toughbook laptop computers.



AN ORDINANCE REZONING LAND LOCATED IN THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSOURI, FROM R-2 SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING DISTRICT TO R-4 MOBILE HOME DWELLING DISTRICT AND FROM B-2 HIGHWAY BUSINESS DISTRICT TO R-4 MOBILE HOME DWELLING DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Land rezoned from R-2 Single Family Dwelling District to R-4 Mobile Home Dwelling District. The following described property located in the City of Canton, Missouri, is rezoned from R-2 Single Family Dwelling District to R-4 Mobile Home Dwelling District:





AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION
205.030, DEFINITIONS, OF THE MUNICIPAL
CODE OF THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSOURI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Section 205.030, Definitions, amended. From and after the effective date of this ordinance Section 205.030, Definitions, of the Municipal Code of the City of Canton, Missouri, shall be amended and from and after the effective date of this ordinance shall be and appear as follows:

“Section 205.030: Definitions

When used in this Article, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

OPEN BURNING: Combustion of any matter, except in a closed chamber. For the purpose of this definition, a chamber shall be regarded as closed when provided, during the time combustion takes place, with only such apertures, ducts, stacks, flues or chimneys as are necessary to provide combustion air and to permit the escape of exhaust gases.

REFUSE: Garbage, rubbish, trade waste, salvageable material, agricultural waste or other waste.

SALVAGE OPERATION: Any business, trade, industry or other activity conducted in whole or in part for the purpose of salvaging or reclaiming any product or material.

TRADE WASTE: The solid, liquid or gaseous material resulting from construction or the prosecution of any business, trade or industry or any demolition operation including, but not limited to, the following: plastics, cardboard cartons, grease, oil, chemicals, cinders, garbage, tires, any materials containing rubber, waste petroleum products, paints and paint thinners, coal, plywood, particle board, any materials containing asphalt or asbestos.”


SECTION TWO. Remainder of Chapter 205 ratified and confirmed. All provisions of Chapter 205 of the Municipal Code of the City of Canton, Missouri, not specifically herein amended shall remain unchanged, and are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION THREE. Prior inconsistent ordinances repealed. All prior ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with or inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed.




