

EARLY PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Canton, Missouri is proposing to purchase a number of blighted properties along the river front with funds received by the Missouri Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), for the purpose of demolishing blighted buildings, cleaning up hazardous materials and removing debris from the property. The rail road station will be stabilized for future restoration.

The properties in this project are located at; 201 Lewis Street, 102 S. Second Street, 101 Lewis Street, 100 First Street, 700 First Street, 201 Marion Street, 700 S. Fourth Street, 101 Clark Street, 101 First Street, 201 Washington Street. The project will involve ten properties located in the 100-year floodplain and wetland.

The City of Canton is interested in discussing alternatives to this project and securing public perceptions of possible adverse impacts that could result from the project and possible mitigation measures. This notice is required by Section 2(a)(4) of Executive Order 11988 for floodplain management and Section (b) of Executive Order 11990 for protection of wetlands, and is implemented by HUD Regulations found at 24 CFR 55.
